Rank Unmet Needs:

1. Public transportation (for individuals who do not otherwise qualify)
 - Work (31.82%)
 - Groceries (32.00%)
2. Drivers
3. Resources and funding for transportation services
4. Education on transportation programs and providers
5. Extended hours
 - Highest time of need 3pm-6pm (37.04%)
 - Weekends
6. Accessible vehicles
7. Active Transportation options i.e. biking, walking, etc.

Goal Setting

- With strategies to obtaining the goals
 - Identify a lead agency or agencies who qualify to apply for funding
 - Funding to hire professional transportation staff member
 - Possibly being county employee
 - Maintaining and updating fleet of vehicles already in county
 - Seek additional funding to maintain fleet
 - Increase drivers
